PETC England exists to provide a forum for the sector to discuss issues of strategic importance on all aspects of Playwork education, training and qualifications in England.

The Playwork Foundation currently provides secretariat to PETC England in order to support a strong voice for the needs of playwork workforce in England.

The Chair of PETC England will:

- Chair 2-4 meetings of the Council per year, held online
- Act as an impartial chair
- Liaise with other PETCs on issues of relevance to the 4 Nations
- Take forward selected actions from PETC England meetings

The Chair of PETC England will need to have knowledge and experience of some or all of the following:

- the playwork sector
- training and qualifications in England including FE and/or HE.
- the needs of playwork employers
- development and accreditation of qualifications
